REFUGEE DONATIONS

Thank you to all individuals, plus the Grove Benevolent Fund, for the magnificent response to my request for funds towards van hire and fuel.

I have not yet got to Calais as the Leeds overview meeting (called to coordinate the many groups responding to this crisis) pointed to more local need.

I have been to Wakefield (the national initial holding centre for all legal refugees) where there are 300 men with only what they stand up in. Clothing and toiletries gratefully received.

I have also done several trips for Mill Hill chapel (City square) taking Horsforth clothing donations to their church and onward to Meanwood . Leeds City Council have given them a warehouse where goods are sorted, destination Calais and Koz.

The response from Christians in Leeds has been both immediate and impressive. I remain 'ready and waiting' for further instructions, having the money to respond quickly. I will keep you posted.
