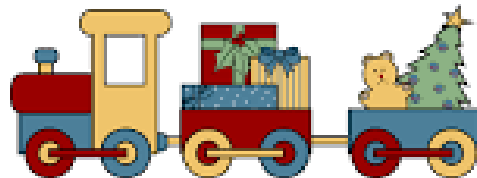


TOY SERVICE – Many thanks to Bryan and Katie Whitham for receiving your gift of toys.
