a unique moment for meeting with  
God. Peaceful Communion with  
God can do without words. How is  
it possible to reach this inner  
silence? Sometimes we are  
apparently silent and yet we have  
great turmoil within. Calming our  
souls requires a kind of simplicity:  
"I do not occupy myself with  
things too great and too  
marvellous for me". Silence means  
leaving to God what is beyond my  
reach and capacity.
