Shirley is grateful for the £139.25p that was raised in the July-August Carboy and that will now improve opportunities for severely abused, pregnant, teenage girls. Shirley says that the girls fortunate enough to be given residence in this safe haven are the worst of many more victims, all of whom are extremely traumatised and distressed on entry. She is seeing transformations as the girls are accompanied on their journeys from desperation to freedom. The donations help the project make a very real difference by supporting the girls through pregnancy and delivery, by showing the new mothers how to care for their babies and by teaching them a trade so that the girls can provide for themselves and their child.
